Rituraj Singh is an outstanding bowling all-rounder who has represented Rajasthan and India A throughout his prolific career spanning over 11 years.

Singh's first-class journey began in December 2011, making his debut for Rajasthan in a 4-day fixture. The classy right-arm seamer took the new ball and claimed match figures of 4/124 across the two innings. Since then Rituraj has gone on to play 51 first-class matches in his career claiming 171 wickets at 27.54 with an economy rate of 3.06.

Whilst known for his bowling, particularly in red-ball cricket, Singh is a notable batter in the lower-middle order with 1136 runs at 18.03, including 4 half-centuries in first-class cricket.

The Indian bowler has also played white ball cricket for his State numerous throughout his career. The 31-year-old has represented Rajasthan in 21 List-A and 25 T20's where he has taken 35 wickets and continues to develop this side of the game even towards the backend of what's been a fantastic domestic career.

The talented all-rounder is now looking to impress down under this winter and hopes a new challenge at a new club can bring out the form this professional is renowned for in India. Any club that seeks a high-class, proven performer, with bat and ball, should seriously consider Rituraj, who is arguably one of the best overseas available to play a full season in the southern hemisphere this campaign.
