Nurul Hasan, who made his first-class debut in 2011, is one of a whole host of talented Bangladesh wicketkeepers who had to wait his turn to play international cricket.

It wasn't entirely his fault though. For 20 years, the position behind the stumps was the domain of Khaled Mashud or Mushfiqur Rahim.

Nurul made his T20I debut in January 2016, against Zimbabwe, and has since become Bangladeshi's key gloveman playing over 60 international matches (albeit the majority in T20I cricket - 46 games). He has impressed, averaging 24.62 in his 9 Test matches, 82.50 in 5 ODI's, and 16.48 with a strike rate of 118.35 in 46 T20Is.

Despite his age, Nurul is now a veteran of 400-plus domestic matches and is on the verge of 10,000 runs with 12 centuries across the three formats.

The run machine is a high-quality performer, who is keen to explore cricket abroad in 2024 (and beyond). He has initially targeted a season in the UK but is also open to other avenues, including T20 cricket around the globe.
