Dippu Sangma is an exciting prospect who shot to prominence in January 2020 by becoming the first A-chik (native) cricketer from Meghalaya to score a first-class century.

His 114 in their Ranji Trophy match helped set-up a resounding innings and 425-run victory over Mizoram.

He has since become a Meghalaya regular in all formats and was the current vice-captain of the side last summer.

A genuine all-rounder Sangma broke into the Meghalaya side in November 2018 and has since played over 50 matches across all formats.

Whilst known for Ranji century, he is predominantly a front-line seamer who boasts impressive domestic numbers, to include 34 wickets at 34.11 in Ranji Trophy cricket.

He has become a key performer for a Meghalaya side that features the likes of record-breaking skipper, Punit Bisht.

The talented all-rounder is quite the prospect who is looking to join his team-mates in the UK next summer. He is a player that comes highly recommended for the 2024 season.
