Adrian Neill, born on March 22, 1994, in Riversdale, South Africa, is a professional cricketer who represents Scotland at the international level. Standing at an imposing height of 6 feet 9 inches, he is a right-handed batsman and a right-arm medium-fast bowler, primarily serving as an enforcement bowler for his teams. The big quick is relocating to the Western Suburbs of Melbourne with his partner, on a Subclass 482 visa.

International Career with Scotland

Neill made his Twenty20 International (T20I) debut for Scotland on February 17, 2019, against Oman during the Oman Quadrangular Series. In this match, he delivered an impressive performance by taking three wickets, earning him the Player of the Match accolade. He debuted in One Day Internationals (ODI) on August 15, 2019, facing Oman in the Scotland Tri-Nation Series. As of June 25, 2023, Neill has participated in nine ODI matches, securing 14 wickets with an average of 24.42, and five T20I matches, taking nine wickets at an average of 17.11.

Domestic Career

Before his international debut, Neill played for Gloucestershire's Second XI, honing his skills in the English county circuit from 2017 till 2019. In Scotland, he has been associated with Heriot's Cricket Club, a powerhouse club based in Edinburgh. Heriot's First XI competes in the Eastern Premier League and has a history of producing Scottish internationals. The team won the Eastern Premier League and the Scottish Cup in 2024, In addition to his playing role,

Neill contributes to Heriot's Cricket Club as part of the cricket committee, reflecting his commitment to the development of the club and the sport at the grassroots level.

Playing Style and Impact

Neill's towering height and bowling skills make him a formidable presence on the field, capable of delivering challenging deliveries to batsmen. His contributions have been instrumental in both his club's successes and Scotland's international campaigns in many non favourable bowling conditions across the cricket world league 2 venues.

As of January 2025, Adrian Neill continues to be an integral part of Scotland's bowling attack, bringing experience and skill to the national team. His ongoing involvement with Heriot's Cricket Club underscores his dedication to fostering cricket talent in Scotland.

No doubt a serious pick up for any club in the Western Suburbs of Melbourne.
