Afaq Ahmed is an emerging Pakistani cricketer known for his technical soundness, mental resilience, and consistency as a top-order batter.

A right-handed batsman, he has progressed steadily through Pakistan's age-group and domestic cricket system, earning recognition for his discipline and adaptability across formats.

Afaq rose to prominence during the Pakistan Inter-Regional Under-19 Championship 2018-19, where his consistent run-scoring earned him the Best Batter Award, marking him as one of the country's standout young prospects. His performances at the junior level laid a strong foundation for his transition into senior domestic cricket.

At the domestic level, Afaq has featured in First-Class, List A, and T20 cricket, gaining valuable experience against seasoned bowlers. His temperament and decision-making have been particularly impressive in the 50-over format, reflected in a List A average of 86.50. His highest scores of 68 in First-Class and List A cricket, and 61 in T20s—highlight his ability to perform at the top level.




Afaq has a big future ahead of him and is targeting a season in the UK to gain valuable experience and welcomes the responsibility of being a clubs overseas pro. He can bowl competent off spin and also has the added bonus of being able to source accommodation in multiple areas of the UK which makes him even more of a quality proposition to clubs who may be struggling with their accommodation.

A gem of a pro waiting to be unearthed, Afaq would be a great addition to any club for the coming summer.
