He has also enjoyed 2 prolific seasons in the UK for Wellington CC (623 runs @ 56.64 & 31 wickets @ 14.61) and Doncaster Town CC (1,061 runs @ 44.21 & 21 wickets @ 20.10). He is not only a stand out pro on the pitch however, he is keen to immerse himself in club life and add value with his experience and coaching junior cricketers whilst in the UK.

Beyond the field, Bhargav Merai is also the founder of La Energia, a sports nutrition and clean-energy food brand inspired by his experience as a professional athlete.
