

His assets are best utilised in red ball however he also possesses the skills to adjust to shorter formats. With the bat, Dan's natural position is in the middle order, as a hard hitting batsmen who particularly looks to dominate spin. He has also successfully been used as an opening batter in both red ball and white ball when required by the team. He has provided a number of match winning counter attacking innings for his team, averaging over 35 last year at a strike rate above 100.

Dan has also managed junior sections as a head coach, overseeing over 150 juniors across a variety of age groups, delivering sessions, offering 1:1s and transitioning new players from softball to hardball. He has excelled most in supporting girls cricket, growing the game for girls looking to get into the sport as well as supporting promising junior players as they look to made the step up to adult or representative cricket.

Dan has also spent the last four years working in an SEND school, specialising in Autism and behaviour management. He has taught sport to a number of young people with additional needs.
