Daniel Stanley is an explosive left-hand top-order batter and useful seamer playing for Heathcote in the Christchurch Metro Cricket Association.

A former New Zealand Under-19 and Canterbury A representative, Stanley has been a stand-out in Premier cricket in recent years since his move from Old Boys' Collegians to his current club Heathcote.

In 2021/22, he was the Roger Blunt Memorial Trophy recipient courtesy of his extraordinary summer. The punishing left-hander topped the Christchurch Metro Premiership run charts. His tally (1,021 runs at 46) was the fifth-highest aggregate in Canterbury history after Walter Hadlee (1,110 runs in 1941/42), Roger Blunt (1,071 runs in 1924/25), Oscar Wilson (1,044 runs in 2020/21), and Ben Harris (1,040 runs in 1987/88).

Holder of a UK Ancestry Visa, Stanley has also produced runs aplenty abroad with successful stints with Formby (2017) sandwiched between two with Richmond (2016, 2018), then last summer with Bracebridge Heath (2023). Over his four seasons, Stanley has racked up well over 3,000 runs and nearly 100 wickets with his brisk medium pace.

The kiwi all-rounder is unavailable in 2024, but will consider options the following season.
