Farhad Reza is an explosive all-rounder who has played 47 matches for Bangladesh. A domestic legend, Reza is on the verge of 10,000 runs and 750 wickets during his prolific 20 plus year / 500 plus game career.

He played the first of his 34 ODI's and 13 T20I's in 2006 before playing his final outing in 2014. Nevertheless, despite being off the national radar, Reza has continued to lord the domestic circuit for various sides.

During his illustrious career, he has enjoyed tremendous success across the three formats. With the bat, he boasts the quickest Dhaka Premier League fifty (scored from 18 balls), 7 first-class centuries, including a highest score of 259 and a further 45 half-centuries in red and white-ball cricket.

With the ball, his skilful medium-pace has accounted for almost 750 wickets, with averages in the twenties across the three formats. He has taken 14 five-wicket hauls, including best red-ball bowling figures of 7-32.

Reza is quite the all-rounder who, having not played in the UK since his Bangladesh A days, returned in 2022 to play club cricket for Lindfield in the Sussex League. Following his delay owing to visa delays, he impressed hitting 367 runs at 40.78 alongside 14 wickets at 21.50

The talented Bangladeshi is now eager for a UK return in 2026, and Franchise opportunities moving forward.

Note: Reza's eligibility window for UK club cricket (based on 5 FC matches in the last 36 months) remains open until 17 Oct 2025.
