George Compton is a fast opening bowler who competes in the Surrey Championship Premier League, widely regarded as one of the strongest club cricket competitions in the UK. He has played at this level for the past five seasons, representing both Weybridge CC and, more recently, Sutton CC.

Alongside his cricket, George has recently completed a Master's degree in Civil Engineering at Loughborough University. During his five years at the university, he trained and competed at a high level, culminating in helping Loughborough win the BUCS National Championship.

George developed his fast bowling through the National Fast Bowling Academy (NFBA), where he was clocked at 84 mph. His performances earned him selection for Hampshire CCC Second XI in 2024, and he is aiming to return this season or next as he continues to push for his first professional contract.

He is a qualified ECB Core Coach (Level 2) and is a player who will surely be a popular pick for the coming season.
