Hartejassvi Kapoor is a talented Indian seamer currently plying his trade at first-class level for Chandigarh in the prestigious Ranji Trophy. A bowler with genuine skill and resilience, Hartejassvi's journey is one marked by early promise, setbacks, and a determined rise to the top tier of domestic cricket in India.

Identified as a standout from a young age, Hartejassvi was selected to represent Punjab at just 15, excelling throughout his junior years all the way through to the under-19 level. However, a string of injuries stalled his early momentum and delayed his transition into the senior ranks. His persistence paid off in 2022, when he finally made his first-class debut for Chandigarh against a strong Madhya Pradesh side. Despite his team falling to a heavy defeat, Hartejassvi showed his class with figures of 2/64 from 21 tidy overs — a promising start on a tough day for his side.

Now a few seasons in, he has featured in 11 first-class matches, regularly sharing the new ball or operating first change on some of the most unforgiving, batter-friendly pitches in the world. While he's still finding his feet at that level statistically, there's little doubt among those who've seen him bowl that he has the ability to become a high-quality professional seamer. With good pace, a strong wrist position, and the ability to swing the ball, his skillset is tailor-made for UK conditions, where lateral movement is more rewarded.

Highly regarded by those within the Indian domestic scene, Hartejassvi comes recommended by fellow CricX professional Jagjit Sharma as a bowler with the tools to make a real impact in league cricket. He's hungry to prove himself overseas and is keen to seize an opportunity to bring his game to the UK for the 2026 season.

For clubs looking to invest in a high-upside seamer who offers pace, movement, and a professional attitude, Hartejassvi Kapoor could be a genuine asset. He's overcome adversity to reach this level and now looks ready to take the next step in his career — potentially on the greener, seam-friendly tracks of the UK.
