Isaac Dikgale is a talented batter playing for the ITEC Knights in South African domestic cricket.

Since his debut in March 2016, Dikgale has played over 100 domestic matches. He has featured for several provincial sides including the likes of North West, Western Province, Cape Cobras, Central Gauteng, and now represents the Free State Knights.

Throughout his career, he has racked up 2,000 plus runs with his solitary century (101\*) being his highlight to date. Dikgale has also enjoyed higher representative honours, having featured for a South African Invitation XI, and the South Africa Emerging Players during the 2017/18 season.

The batting all-rounder has also enjoyed three successful seasons in England, initially in the Bradford League (2022-23) for Lightcliffe, then in the West of England Premier League (2024) for Warminster.

During his two-season stint for Lightcliffe, he has racked up 1,201 runs at 42.89 with 5 fifties, 3 hundreds, and a highest score of 152. He also bagged 40 wickets at 15.73 with best figures of 5-21 with his off-spin. Last summer the trend continued in the WEPL for Warminster racking up 516 runs at 39.69 alongside 16 wickets at 17.69.

For the 2025 season, Dikgale played for Oxford in the Home Counties Premier League and had another fruitful summer, impressing both on and off the pitch with his all round efforts at the club. A strong option and a proven UK performer

who is now set to return to Oxford CC for a second stint in 2026.
