Jack Harris is a right-arm medium-fast opening bowler and lower-order batsman from the Manawatu region in Central Districts, New Zealand.

Known for his calm, easy-going nature off the field and fierce dedication on it, Harris brings a disciplined and focused mindset to training and match days, always giving 100% in pursuit of team success.

Having represented Manawatu Senior Men's side with distinction, Harris has featured in 46 matches, claiming 89 wickets at an impressive average of 21.13, with a best of 6/43 and three five-wicket hauls. At the club level, he's been a consistent force for United Cricket Club Prems, racking up 205 wickets in 93 matches, including 10 five-wicket hauls and a standout best bowling performance of 7/32, maintaining an impressive economy rate of 3.05.

His dedication and steady rise culminated in a first-class debut for the Central Stags back in December 2024 at Bay Oval, Mt Maunganui — a proud moment in his cricketing journey. In that match, he bowled 28 overs across two innings, picking up 2 wickets at an economy of 3.03.

Harris has also gained valuable international experience through school tours in India, Sri Lanka, and Australia, and a full club season in the Airwharf Cricket League in the UK, further developing his game in a range of conditions.

Whether steaming in with the new ball or producing valuable runs down the order, Harris is a team-first cricketer with

a strong work ethic and an unwavering commitment to improvement.

Available for Holland & The Republic Of Ireland due his 'Pathway' status, Jack is seeking his first stint in the Northern Hemisphere ahead of the 2026 season. No doubt an impressive individual, we expect the Kiwi to be a valuable asset both on and off the pitch.
