Jacob Binnersely is an exciting all rounder (seam) who has just enjoyed a breakthrough season in the UK.

A genuine all rounder who bowls very good seam and bats in the top order, Jacob is fresh off the back of an outstanding club season in the highly competitive Shropshire County Premier League.

Playing for Sentinel CC, the youngster picked up the young player of the season award across the whole league. This was just rewards after impressing with 43 wickets (across all competitions) at an average of 21.16 and 735 runs at an average of 28.27, including a career best 102* in the Premier Division vs St Georges CC. Batting at number four, his century came from just 91 deliveries and included X5 sixes and x6 fours and was instrumental in his teams 27 run victory. It is clear to see we have guite a talent on our hands here.

His performances also earned several notable club awards, with him being awarded player of the season, young player of the season and also scooping the performance of the season for Sentinel CC. he is now looking to break in to the minor county scene and is targeting full Shropshire CCC selection (after representing the Under 18s over the last couple of years) which surely will not be far away given his current form and trajectory.

Jacob is certainly on a high and a man in immense form. He is targeting a southern hemisphere season to continue to develop his game with a view to pushing on for higher honours in the near future. He is a qualified ECB Level 1 coach and is keen to get involved in thais aspect of club life and add as much value as possible both on and off the pitch.
