Off the field, Bradley has shown leadership qualities beyond his years—named Vice-Captain of the First XI and previously holding the honour of being the youngest player to captain the Club's First XI back in 2024.

Now seeking to broaden his cricketing experience, James is eager to spend the 2025/26 season overseas, where he can test himself in new conditions, continue developing his game, and immerse himself fully in club life.
