Joshua Lawrenson, an accomplished top-order batter and right-arm off-spin bowler, has consistently delivered impressive performances on the field in both international and domestic cricket.

From a young age, Joshua showcased his cricketing potential, playing age group cricket for Jersey. His leadership qualities shone through early, as he captained age group sides from U13 to U19, even leading the U19 team in a World Cup Qualifier.

Joshua's contributions have been instrumental in elevating the Jersey men's team to their highest level of performance ever. He was part of the team that won the ICC World Challenge League B tournament, scoring one century and three half-centuries whilst averaging close to 50. He was acknowledged as one of the players of the tournament. His standout moment came in the following tournament in Namibia, when he was part of the 8th highest ODI partnership in history, hitting Jersey's first ever ODI ton in the process.

In a shorter format, Josh stood out again for Jersey in the European Cricket Championship T10 tournament, hitting 24*(4) in the semi-final, and guiding his team home with an explosive 68*(24) in the final of the competition.

Away from international cricket, Josh has represented Durham University UCCE (University Centre of Cricketing Excellence) 1st XI and was awarded colours for three years of outstanding performance. He also played club cricket whilst at university, averaging over 50 for Crook Town Cricket Club during the three years he played for them.
