Keshana Fonseka (19), a professional cricketer for Lancashire County Cricket Club and current England U19 international.

A technically gifted top-order batter, Fonseka is a product of Lancashire's elite pathway, having progressed through the ranks since the age of 10. His development has seen him rise through County Age Groups, onto the EPP (Elite Player Programme), the Academy, and ultimately earning his first professional contract with the County.

Kesh made his Lancashire First XI debut against Middlesex, scoring a composed 42 at the top of the order. While opportunities in the First Team have been limited to date, he is set to play a key role in the upcoming One Day Competition.

His County performances have also been recognised at national level, earning selection for the England U19 side. He has impressed on the international stage, averaging 50.6 in Youth Test matches — including a fluent 87 on debut against Sri Lanka — and averaging 57.75 in Youth ODIs with a standout knock of 121 against Ireland. A winter injury ruled him out of the Australia series, but he returned strongly on England's tour of South Africa in 2024/25.

Off the field, Kesh is a qualified ECB Level Two Coach and is eager to get involved in his new Club's coaching programme, mentoring younger players and contributing to the wider club environment.

Now looking to test himself in Australian conditions for the 2025/26 season, Keshana is keen to immerse himself fully in his chosen Club's culture and make a lasting impact both on and off the field.
