Luke Maslen (20) is an exciting right-handed top-order batsman from Oxfordshire, England.

A current member of the Exeter University High-Performance 1st XI, Luke is a classical batsman who has a fantastic record in club cricket across recent years. The talented youngster plays his club cricket for Oxford Downs and racked up 543 runs across 16 innings in 2022, averaging 36.20 including four half-centuries.

Furthermore, Maslen added a Minor Counties hundred to his record in 2022, the right hander played two NCCA Championship games for Oxfordshire CCC and scored 108 not out against Herefordshire to lead his side to victory.

A former participant of the Sussex County Cricket Club EPP pathway during the 2018/2019 winter, the Oxfordshire batter is a superb asset in the field and has an energetic and enthusiastic approach to them game. Vastly experienced at a young age, Luke's career highlight to date is a half-century (56 off 131 balls) in a friendly game for Exeter University against Gloucestershire County Cricket Club back in April 2022.

Now seeking a new challenge, the 20-year-old looks set to head down under to continue his development and experience new conditions for the 2023/24 season. A likeable and hard working individual, Maslen is someone we see succeeding over the season able to contribute regularly both on and off the pitch.
