Manoj Ingale is a skillful new-ball seamer and handy lower-order hitter who has turned out in all three formats for a star-studded Maharashtra side — rubbing shoulders with the likes of Ruturaj Gaikwad, Kedar Jadhav, Rahul Tripathi, and fellow CricX pros Ankit Bawne and Ashay Palkar.

Ingale burst onto the domestic scene in 2020 with a stunning 5-73 on his Ranji Trophy debut against Services. He followed that up with career-best figures of 6-34 vs Tripura just a few matches later, quickly establishing himself as a red-ball threat.

While his white-ball opportunities have been more limited, he made a mark early — famously dismissing Indian star Suresh Raina in his T20 debut during the Syed Mushtag Ali Trophy.

Red-ball cricket has been his strongest suit, with standout Ranji seasons including 14 wickets at 20.57 (2019/20) and consistent returns over subsequent years. Though game time has been scarce since February 2024, Ingale remains committed to forcing his way back into the domestic fold.

Looking ahead to 2026, he's keen to test himself in UK club cricket. And if his performances mirror those of his teammate Ashay Palkar, any club that signs Ingale will be bringing in a genuine impact player.
