Under the guidance of Pakistan international Abid Ali, Ammar continues to develop in the right environment and is widely seen as a future star.

Now looking to bring his game to UK shores in 2026, Mohammad represents a fantastic overseas option for any club. He offers big runs, quality off-spin, and the kind of attitude and enthusiasm that lifts those around him.
