Najiha Alvi is a Pakistan international wicketkeeper-batter and right-handed middle-order batter who has represented Pakistan in both ODI and T20I cricket. She has also represented Pakistan A and Pakistan Women's Emerging Players, gaining valuable experience across international and domestic cricket.

A specialist wicketkeeper, Najiha has taken 94 dismissals in domestic List A and T20 cricket (50 catches, 44 stumpings), and was named Best Wicketkeeper of the National Women's T20 Tournament 2025-26 for her performances behind the stumps for Strikers, having also been recognised as her domestic competition's best wicketkeeper on previous occasions.

In international cricket, she produced a memorable performance against Zimbabwe in May 2026, striking an unbeaten 56 off just 30 balls – her maiden ODI half-century, and the fastest fifty by a Pakistan women's ODI batter, reached in just 24 deliveries. Across 27 international matches for Pakistan (18 ODIs, 9 T20Is), she has recorded 20 dismissals as a wicketkeeper, including 10 catches, 9 stumpings and 1 run-out.

Najiha is now looking forward to bringing her international experience to English county cricket, contributing to a team at a high level and continuing to develop as a professional cricketer.

In her own words:

"My goal is to gain valuable experience in England cricket club, contribute to the team at a high level, and further develop as a wicketkeeper-batter by adapting to different playing conditions and learning from a new cricketing environment. I also aim to pursue Level 2 and Level 3 coaching qualifications in the UK to broaden my cricketing knowledge, develop my coaching skills and continue building a long-term career within the sport."

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
