Newman Nyamhuri is one of Zimbabwe's brightest young stars - a fiery left-arm quick and powerful lower-middle-order batter who made his international debut in December 2024. Since then, he's made an immediate impression in both Tests and ODIs and looks destined for a big future on the global stage.

Nyamhuri first caught attention at the 2024 ICC U19 World Cup, finishing as Zimbabwe's leading wicket-taker (8 wickets at 26.75) and turning heads with his pace, aggression, and match-winning temperament. His standout moment came against Namibia, where he took 4-21 and was named Player of the Match. He also claimed key scalps against Sri Lanka and England — including Essex's Luc Benkenstein and Charlie Ellison in the Super Six clash.

Before the World Cup, Nyamhuri had already built a strong reputation. A product of St Charles College in South Africa, where he received a full scholarship, he was named Best Bowler at back-to-back ESTON SA Schools Championships (2022 & 2023). His rise included Zimbabwe U25 selection in 2023, followed by U19 stardom and eventual elevation to the national side.

In the lead-up to the World Cup, he delivered a Man of the Match performance against Ireland — smashing 56 from No. 8 before bagging 3-42 to seal a 32-run win.

Fresh off his international breakthrough and a solid UK stint with Leicester Electricity Sports in 2024, Nyamhuri is now seeking further overseas opportunities for 2026. A genuine all-round threat, he's a name to watch - and a

game-changer for any club lucky enough to secure his services.
