Nimnaka Jayathilake is a gifted slow left-arm orthodox spinner and useful lower-order batter who has been turning heads since making his first-class debut for Sinhalese Sports Club in 2022. In just 11 first-class matches, he's already claimed 41 wickets at an average of 26.04, with best figures of 5 for 52—a testament to his control, consistency, and ability to strike in crucial moments.

In 2024, Nimnaka ventured to the UK for his maiden season abroad and made an immediate impact with Cookham Dean CC in the Thames Valley League Division One. He quickly established himself as a key performer, finishing the campaign with 47 wickets at just 19.43. His influence extended far beyond the scorecard—his presence, professionalism, and commitment to the club were widely appreciated by teammates and members alike.

While in the UK, he also took the opportunity to complete his ECB Core Coaching qualification, demonstrating his eagerness to contribute beyond just playing. Passionate about developing young cricketers, Nimnaka is particularly keen to take on junior coaching responsibilities, bringing energy, experience, and genuine care to the role.

Looking ahead to the 2026 season, Nimnaka is set on returning to the UK for another full campaign. With his ever-reliable left-arm spin, ability to contribute with the bat, and his growing coaching credentials, he brings tremendous all-round value to any club—on the field and within the wider cricketing community.
