Nurul Hasan is a seasoned Bangladesh international wicketkeeper-batter who has been a consistent performer across formats for over a decade. Making his first-class debut in 2011, Nurul had to bide his time for an international breakthrough, with the gloves occupied by Khaled Mashud and Mushfigur Rahim for two decades.

He made his T20I debut in January 2016 against Zimbabwe and has since played over 60 international matches, primarily in T20Is. His career highlights include:

Tests: 11 matches, 440 runs at 22.00, 25 catches, 9 stumpings.

ODIs: 7 matches, 165 runs at an impressive 82.50 average, 6 catches, 4 stumpings.

T20Is: 46 matches, 445 runs at a 118.35 strike rate, 21 catches, 9 stumpings.

In Bangladesh's domestic scene, Nurul is a veteran of nearly 500 professional matches, boasting outstanding numbers:

First-Class: 111 matches, 5,505 runs at 36.94 with 12 centuries and 23 fifties; 283 catches, 55 stumpings.
