Domestically, Peter-Daniel has been a standout performer for his club's Premier League side for the past three years, playing a crucial role in their back-to-back league titles in 2023 and 2024. His impact with the ball was particularly notable as he finished as the second-highest wicket-taker in the 2024 Premier League season. His consistent excellence earned him the Junior Sportsman Award at his club in both 2022 and 2023, underscoring his steady development and growing influence on the field.

Peter-Daniel's bowling is characterized by a smart blend of economy and wicket-taking ability, making him a valuable asset who can both control the game and turn matches with key breakthroughs. His batting provides important middle-order stability, adding all-round value to his teams. Beyond his skills, he possesses a strong mentality and clear ambition, with his sights firmly set on becoming a mainstay in Namibia's senior national team. His intention to gain experience overseas by playing club cricket in 2026 highlights his commitment to continuous improvement and adapting to varied conditions.

With his impressive early career and international exposure at such a young age, Peter-Daniel is an exciting prospect for clubs looking for a dynamic, hardworking player with both talent and vision. A season abroad could accelerate his development and further enhance his prospects on the global stage.
