Ram Gurung is a dynamic all-rounder who made an immediate impact on the Ranji Trophy stage with a debut to remember in January 2024. Batting at No.3 for Meghalaya, he smashed a brilliant 132 on debut before showcasing his seam-bowling prowess two matches later with a sensational 6-15 against Nagaland.

Though he made his white-ball debut back in 2021, Gurung had to wait over two years for his first-class opportunity—one he seized emphatically. He finished his maiden Ranji season with 209 runs at 23.22 and 10 wickets at 23.90, despite featuring in just two matches.

A genuine all-rounder with the ability to win games with bat or ball, Gurung is hungry for more opportunities in the 2025/26 Indian domestic season. In the meantime, he's seeking his first UK club stint for 2026—a hugely exciting prospect for clubs looking to add impact and balance to their side.
