A stylish top-order batter who can also bowl handy seam-up, Ganganath has already begun to turn heads in Sri Lankan cricket circles.

He burst onto the domestic scene during the 2022/23 season, making his debut for a star-studded Police SC side featuring national talents such as Kusal Perera, Ashen Bandara, Malinda Pushpakumara, and CricX standout Priyamal Perera. Despite the high-profile company, Ganganath made an immediate impression with his calm temperament and all-round potential.

A proud product of the renowned Isipathana College, Colombo—alma mater to legends including Aravinda de Silva, Asanka Gurusinha, and Nuwan Zoysa—Ganganath is continuing the school's rich cricketing legacy. Having already represented Sri Lanka at U15 level and impressed in U19 provincial competitions, he is now firmly focused on establishing himself in the professional game.

A naturally fluent stroke-maker, Ganganath is known for his ability to score freely at the top of the order, and his swing bowling makes him an even more valuable asset—especially in English conditions where seam movement can be decisive. His skill set makes him a genuine all-round option ideally suited to UK club cricket.

Looking ahead to 2026, Ganganath is eager to broaden his horizons with a stint in the UK. He already has

accommodation available in the Liverpool area, but remains open to offers from across the country. For clubs seeking a versatile, motivated young cricketer with plenty of upside, Randunu Ganganath is a standout option.
