Born in Taunton, Somerset in the South of England, the bowling all-rounder grew up in Perth, representing Western Australia throughout junior cricket before returning to the UK.


After trialling with Gloucestershire County Cricket Club during the Summer of 2014, the now Australian Citizen went on to make his professional debut against Glamorgan in a T20 fixture later that same summer.

The now 30-year-old was awarded a one-year contract before been released at the end of the 2015 season. Since then, Montgomery has gone on to forge an impressive club career in Western Australia with both bat and ball.

In 258 games, the British Passport holder has chalked up nearly 6000 runs at an average of 25, whilst also taking 256 wickets at an average of 22. A destructive right-hander capable of scoring at over a run a ball, Robbies main skill is opening the bowling with his right arm seam.

The former County man is a genuine match winner and still has a strong passion for the game. Seeking a return to the Northern Hemisphere at the conclusion of the current Australian Summer, the experienced performer is seeking opportunities in Holland or the UK for the 2026 season.
