Since debuting in 2023 for FATA Region in the Quaid-e-Azam Trophy, Salman has become a regular in the side. In his first 11 matches, he's averaged close to 40, notching up a century and three half-centuries—solid numbers that reflect his consistency and growing maturity at the crease.

Even before his first-class debut, Salman's talent was clear. In 2021, he was selected for the Pakistan Shaheens for a one-day match against Sri Lanka—an impressive achievement for a player yet to break into the domestic red-ball circuit. That experience, sharing a dressing room with names like Salman Agha, Saud Shakeel, and Naseem Shah, proved both a challenge and a huge learning opportunity for the young batter.

Now, with a solid foundation at home, Salman is looking to take the next step in his cricketing journey. He's keen to experience an overseas season in 2026, where he can continue to grow as a cricketer and contribute on and off the field. With his ability to chip in with the ball and his calm presence with the bat, he offers real all-round value.

For any club looking for a composed top-order batter who can also send down some tidy overs, Salman is a fantastic option—and with his potential, he's only just getting started.

Salman is now set to showcase his talents in the UK after signing with North Staffs South Cheshire League club Norton in Hales CC.
