Sarah Barber is a versatile batting all-rounder who has captained the KwaZulu-Natal Inland Senior Women's side and steadily built an impressive résumé across South African and overseas cricket. A product of Wembley College, she broke into the KZN Inland U19s at just 14, going on to represent South Africa U19 Fillies in 2018, the U19 Girls in 2021, and feature for both KZN Inland Women (2017/18–2022/23) and Central Gauteng Women (2023/24). Originally a frontline seamer, she has evolved her game since COVID, moving from a lower-order role to becoming a dependable top-middle-order batter while continuing to offer incisive bowling spells.

Her domestic record reflects her dual skill set, with highlights including 12 wickets at just 13.25 in T20 cricket and useful contributions across List A formats. Overseas, Barber has thrived using her UK Ancestry Visa, enjoying standout seasons with Beaconsfield in the Home Counties Women's Cricket League (2022) and Hursley Park in the Hampshire Women's Cricket League (2023 and 2025). Across her UK stints, she has amassed 1,498 runs at 34.84 and taken 51 wickets at 26.65, while also featuring for Buckinghamshire U18s, the Sir JP Getty's XI, and the MCC Women. She has further broadened her experience with a season in Melbourne for Edinburgh.

Barber's adaptability, leadership experience, and proven ability to contribute in multiple roles make her a valuable acquisition for any side. Whether pursuing university studies or returning for another UK summer, the Ancestry Visa-holding South African remains a sought-after prospect for 2026.
