Hailing from the Southern Province of Sri Lanka, he is a proud product of Dharmasoka College, Ambalangoda - a school known for producing several national-level cricketers over the years.

Sasindu represented all age groups during his time at Dharmasoka College, consistently showcasing his skills with both bat and gloves. His performances at school level earned him a place at the prestigious Sinhalese Sports Club (SSC), one of the most storied and successful cricket clubs in Sri Lanka.

In 2023, Sasindu made his first-class debut under the captaincy of Charith Asalanka, following strong performances in SSC's Under-23 tournaments.

During the 2024–2025 domestic season, he gained invaluable experience playing alongside Sri Lankan Test captain Dimuth Karunaratne, Kusal Mendis, Prabath Jayasuriya, and other national players.

That season, Sasindu hit a rich vein of form, scoring 279 runs at an impressive average of 46.50.

Following the season, Sasindu headed to Panadura Sports Club, where he continued to shine in the Under-23 tournament, scoring 325 runs, with 4 half-centuries at an average of 54.00.

His first class career is under way with a bang, already with a century to his name and an average in the mid 40's, it is clear to see the talent that Sasindu has. He comes recommended by proven UK pro and CricX stable mate Imesh Udayanga.

Sasindu Malshan continues to grow as a promising cricketer in Sri Lanka's domestic circuit. With his well-rounded skillset, exposure to top-level players, and consistent performances, he is certainly a name to watch in the coming seasons.
