His domestic exploits led to an IPL contract with the Gujarat Lions in 2017. Though he only featured in one match, he made an immediate impact by dismissing the legendary Hashim Amla. Sharing a dressing room with the likes of Brendon McCullum, Aaron Finch, Ravindra Jadeja, and Suresh Raina provided invaluable experience and only sharpened his competitive edge.

Back on the domestic scene, he has remained a key figure for Chhattisgarh, consistently delivering match-winning performances and contributing in both departments. With the bat, Shubham is an aggressive presence in the middle order—capable of turning the tide of a match with quick runs under pressure, making him an ideal T20 and one-day asset.

Now setting his sights on league cricket in the UK for the 2026 season, Shubham is ready to bring his experience, energy, and all-round impact to a new environment. Known as a team-first player and a positive influence off the field, he is eager to integrate into club life and take on the responsibilities that come with being a professional overseas signing.

For any club looking for a genuine all-rounder with proven pedigree, tactical nous, and the ability to win games single-handedly, Shubham Agarwal is a name worth serious consideration.
