Siraj Uddin is an exciting fast bowling talent making waves in Pakistan's domestic cricket scene. Known for his pace, regularly bowling over 145 km/h, he ranks among the quickest bowlers in the domestic circuit. His recent performances have brought him into the spotlight, highlighted by his representation of Pakistan A against Sri Lanka A, alongside experience in various Pakistan Super League franchises and even stints playing in the USA.

Beyond his bowling threat, Siraj is a valuable lower-order batter. He's shown resilience with notable knocks like an unbeaten 49 batting at number 11 in first-class cricket and a crucial 47 not out in a List A semifinal that helped his team advance to the final.

Between the 2023/24 and 2024/25 seasons, Siraj played 12 first-class matches, taking 29 wickets at an average of 36.31, with best figures of 4 for 7, while maintaining an economy of 3.63. Though still developing, his strike rate of just under 60 balls per wicket shows his ability to take wickets regularly. With the bat, he contributed 130 runs at an average of 16.25 and a strike rate over 92.

In List A cricket during the same period, Siraj featured in 14 matches, capturing 17 wickets at an average of 36.88 and an economy rate of 6.10. His best bowling in the format is 3 for 39. With the bat, he scored 92 runs at 23.00, including a vital unbeaten 47 in a pressure semifinal.




With his raw pace and growing all-round capabilities, Siraj Uddin is a promising prospect aiming to build on his

domestic success and make a mark at higher levels.
