Sumon Khan is a highly skilled right-arm quick and left-handed batter from Bangladesh, renowned for his ability to swing the ball both ways and consistently deliver under pressure. A proven match-winner at domestic level, Sumon has carved out a reputation as one of the most promising pace-bowling talents in the country.

His breakout performances came in the National Cricket League, where he topped the wicket charts twice - in 2019–20 and again in 2022, when he ripped through batting line-ups to claim 49 wickets in just 11 matches. That season included a record-breaking spell of 7 wickets for just 18 runs, including a hat-trick - a highlight that underlined his ability to turn games single-handedly.

Not just a red-ball specialist, Sumon is a consistent performer in List A and T20 formats as well. His standout moment came at the Emerging Teams Asia Cup in 2019, where he finished as the tournament's leading wicket-taker with 14 wickets in just 5 matches. He was also part of the gold-medal-winning squad at the 2019 South Asian Games, and helped secure bronze at the 19th Asian Games (2022).

Having represented both Bangladesh A and the Emerging Team, Sumon earned his international debut against Malaysia in October 2023. Though yet to establish himself at senior level, his domestic form speaks volumes:

Add to that valuable runs down the order — including over 800 First-Class runs — and you have a genuine bowling all-rounder.

A multiple-time NCL Champion, BPL Champion (2022) and Dhaka Premier League Winner (2022), Sumon knows how to win and brings a high-performance mindset to every environment he joins.

Now, looking ahead to his maiden UK club stint in 2026, Sumon is eager to bring his skillset, work ethic, and big-game experience to a competitive side. With his proven ability to lead attacks, contribute with the bat, and add depth to any squad, he'd be a fantastic overseas signing for clubs seeking a dependable match-winner with international pedigree.
