Tadiwanashe Marumani is widely regarded as Zimbabwe’s next big cricket star. At just 22, the explosive left-handed opener has already made a name for himself on the international stage. In October 2024, Maru blasted the fastest T20 international fifty by a Zimbabwean—and the second fastest ever by a full member nation—reaching 50 off just 13 balls against Gambia in the ICC T20 World Cup qualifier.

Since debuting as a teenager against Pakistan in 2021, Marumani has become a mainstay in Zimbabwe’s white-ball sides, opening in 47 internationals and featuring regularly in franchise tournaments like the Zim Afro T10. His rise was rapid; only six weeks after his first-class debut, he was fast-tracked into the national team. Before that, he was a standout at the 2020 ICC Under-19 World Cup, finishing as one of the tournament’s top run-scorers.

Maru made an immediate impact in domestic T20 cricket with the Southern Rocks, scoring multiple quickfire fifties and ending as the second-highest run-scorer in the championship. His form earned him Zimbabwe selection, where he delivered promising performances in both T20s and ODIs, including standout knocks for Zimbabwe A and topping the Pro50 Championship run charts in 2022.

After moving to Mashonaland Eagles, Maru’s first-class form surged—averaging over 70 in the 2023/24 Logan Cup with two centuries, followed by another strong season in 2024/25. A capable wicketkeeper as well, he now combines explosive batting with versatility, making him an invaluable asset to Zimbabwe cricket.

Confident and in peak form, Marumani is eager to build on his success and explore opportunities to showcase his talent on the global stage.
