A product of Durham County Cricket Club, Tom was a mainstay in the county's Academy system from 2016 to 2022, where he developed under the guidance of elite coaches and competed at a high level throughout his youth career. His performances earned him selection for the North of England squad at the prestigious Bunbury Festival in 2019, a key stepping stone toward England U16 representation.

In 2022, Tom chose to step away from the academy pathway to focus on his academic pursuits at university, while continuing to build on his cricketing career at club level.

Currently, he represents Rockliffe Park Cricket Club in the North Yorkshire South Durham Premier League, where he has firmly established himself as a reliable presence behind the stumps and a consistent performer with the bat. To date, he has amassed over 1,200 Premier League runs at an average of 30, along with more than 60 dismissals—a testament to his sharp glovework and game awareness.

With his studies concluding this summer, Tom is now setting his sights on the 2025/26 season in Australia, eager to test himself in new conditions and further refine his skills both with the gloves and the bat.

A composed, hard-working cricketer with a strong foundation and team-first attitude, Tom would be an excellent

addition to any club seeking a high-quality wicket-keeper batter with a strong work ethic and a wealth of experience at a young age.
