Umar Nazir Mir is a seasoned campaigner and a true stalwart of Jammu & Kashmir cricket, having led the pace attack for India's northernmost state for over a decade.

Since making his Ranji Trophy debut in December 2013, Mir has accumulated more than 200 domestic wickets across formats, consistently averaging under 29—an impressive feat for any seamer in Indian conditions.

Over the years, Mir has firmly established himself as J&K's go-to quick, producing standout Ranji campaigns in 2018/19 (26 wickets at 27.84), 2019/20 (28 wickets at 23.03), 2022/23 (14 wickets at 22.28), 2023/24 (20 wickets at 23.28), and most recently 2024/25 (17 wickets at 19.82). His reliability and skill with the ball have made him the heartbeat of the J&K bowling unit.

His domestic success hasn't gone unnoticed—he earned national recognition with selection for India C in the 2018 Deodhar Trophy and for North Zone during the 2017 Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy.

List A: 50 wickets at 30.62 T20: 32 wickets at 19.40 More than just a bowler, Mir is a handy contributor with the bat in the lower order. Though often under the radar, he has produced several important knocks, regularly posting scores between 20 and 40 in five of his last seven Ranji Trophy campaigns.

Having never played abroad, the J&K veteran is now eager to explore new horizons and experience a UK league stint in 2026. With his wealth of experience, skillset, and calm presence, Umar Nazir Mir promises to be a valuable asset to any club next summer.
