Usman Abbasi (22), A highly skilled and experienced left-arm bowler from Nottinghamshire, England

A product of the Nottinghamshire County Cricket Club system, Usman is a sharp left-arm quick capable of swinging the ball both ways with pace and control. Over the past few seasons, he has been a consistent performer for Sandiacre Town Cricket Club, where he has taken 102 First XI wickets to date.

His club performances earned him a call-up to the Derbyshire CCC 2nd XI in 2023, where he continued to impress and move closer to breaking into the County system. In the 2023 season, Usman claimed 39 wickets, including best figures of 5/41, followed by another strong 2024 campaign where he picked up 41 wickets at an average of 22.00, with a best of 4/35.

With the bat, Usman is more than capable in the lower order. Batting regularly at 8 or 9, he averaged 20.25 in 2024, including a standout 60 against Nottinghamshire Premier League side Kimberley Institute CC in a pre-season fixture—highlighting his ability to contribute valuable runs when needed.

Now 22, Usman is looking to test himself further by playing a season in Australia. Eager to gain exposure to overseas conditions, continue his development, and make a name for himself internationally, he brings with him both talent and a professional attitude.

There's no doubt Usman would be a superb signing for any club seeking a genuine left-arm quick who offers wicket-taking threat, lower-order stability, and an undeniable hunger to progress in the game.
